

• Timeframe: 01.01.2025 – 30.06.2025


- Sample frame:
 - TV Central News and Morning Shows: RTS 1, TV Pink, TV Prva, and Happy TV
- Unit of analysis: mentions in media pieces
- **Sample size**: 8,093
- **Topics of analysis**: Politics, Military, Economy, Kosovo, Past conflicts 1990-99, Culture, Human Rights, Health.

The anti-West narrative dominates, with pro-Russian narrative consistently following over the years




CRTH: The US and Russia dominate Serbian media coverage in the first half of 2025


Number of mentions in media pieces




The EU faces the most negative coverage, while Russia and China receive favorable treatment



Significant increase in anti-EU narratives, while anti-US is the only one in a decline




The US recorded the most drastic increase in positive mentions, followed by Russia. The EU is the only entity with a notable decline in positive coverage.




CRTA: Most quoted politician, by far, is Aleksandar Vučić


Number of mentions in media pieces




When Vučić is quoted, pro-US coverage shows the sharpest rise, pro-Russian remains strong, while pro-EU declines in H1 2025




Information manipulation in H1 2025 turns in favor of the US, while the EU tops the list of negative narratives



CRTA: Serbian media sources are most commonly associated with content containing information manipulation



Manipulative narratives affirm China and Russia, while the EU is predominantly portrayed through negative manipulation*



Authoritarian allies receive positive coverage in line with the government narrative, while EU remains underrepresented
